Risk Areas	Action Required	By whom
Assessment and Rapid Lateral Flow Test	<p>Foundation Phase and Senior Phase coaches are required to undergo 2 rapid lateral flow tests per week on Sundays and Wednesdays by local school and Weston College. Similarly, all secondary and college pupils are also asked to undertake the rapid lateral flow tests. If any symptoms show, a PCP test is required and refrain from work until a negative is produced.</p> <p>Coaches and players for adult teams until all coaches and players have had the first vaccination, they should have completed a rapid lateral flow test and provide a negative result by bringing an email/text copy of that on matchday. Packs are easily obtained from the Gov't.</p> <p>Anyone living with a covid relative should not attend any training or matchday activity.</p> <p>It would be appreciated if all opposition teams could adhere to this policy.</p> <p>This Risk Assessment will be sent in advance to the opposition. Large groups training	No more than 30 people training including coaches in any one session. Parents of youth players but must adhere to Gov't guidance on social distancing.	ALL COACHES
Stadium and Ground	<p>Masks should be worn when standing indoors including the Club Shop. Social distancing should also be observed – 2 metre rule when in the ground and no more than 30 congregating together. Multiples of these groups are fine providing social distancing is observed. <p style="text-align: center;">Sanitising</p>	<p>Players and officials should sanitise hands before and after a match. There are hand sanitisers all around club facilities including turnstiles. Cleaning of all rooms including and especially changing facilities after every training session or match must take place. This is of paramount importance as matches often follow directly those just completed. Kit - to clean all equipment including footballs and goalkeeper gloves – using sanitised wipes. The Kitchen Food outlet also has socially distancing mats in place.</p> <p>During preseason and league season matches the Sportsman Bar will offer table service only with a limit of 6 per table and 50 in total for supporters until the turnstiles open until 90 minutes before kO. Players guests will then be invited prior to and during the match.
